



## **Bill Dorenkott:** Coach Speaker



- Director of Men's and Women's Swimming and Diving: Ohio State University
- Head coach of the Ohio State women's swimming program from 2008-2016
- Built the Buckeyes into a consistent contender vying for Big Ten Conference titles and sending athletes to the Olympic Games and World Championships
- Head coach of Penn State's women's program for ten years and men's for three years
- Won three Big Ten championships as the Penn State women's coach
- Coached 28 different student-athletes to 34 Big Ten individual championships
- Coached an NCAA champion in the men's 200 backstroke
- Qualified 57 PSU swimmers for the U.S. Olympic Trials
- His student-athletes set 10 Big Ten records and four Big Ten championship records
- Coached 246 academic All-Big Ten honorees and 48 Scholar (CSCAA) All-Americans
- His student-athletes have competed in the Olympic Games, Pan Am Games, World University Games, World Championships, Pan-Pacific Championships, U.S. National Championships and on the U.S. International circuit
- A member of the USA Swimming National Team coaching staff since 2001
- Served on the U.S. National Team coaching staff during the 2001 World University Games, the 2003 Pan Am Games and the 2007 Japan International Grand Prix
- 15-time conference champion as a student-athlete at Cleveland State
- Bachelor's degrees in both communications and psychology from Cleveland State
