**CODE OF CONDUCT**

Individuals, including spectators, not complying with any safety requirement in place for this competition or with the USA Swimming Code of Conduct or individuals who otherwise impede the effective operation of the meet may be banned from the venue at the discretion of the Meet Director, Meet Referee, and/or Facility Management.

**FACILITY**

The Greensboro Aquatics Center (GAC) is a state-of-the-art indoor facility with a 50-meter pool which can be broken into two short course venues with a separate diving well. This competition will use the long course competition venue that is 8 lanes with continuous warm-up and cool-down lanes available throughout the meet in the training pool. The pool depth is 9'-10' at the start and turn ends and 4" lane lines will be used to reduce turbulence. The lane width is 7'-9' (depending on number of lanes). An Omega timing system with a Daktronics Pro-Star LED Video Scoreboard Display will display results simultaneously. We will use a touchpad and a minimum of one (1) button and one (1) watch per lane. Starting platforms are Omega deck anchored platforms. EAC will ensure the correct competition course dimensions. Prior to each session of competition, the facility host shall examine the bulkhead and shall confirm to the Meet Referee that the bulkhead is stable, straight

and properly positioned and anchored. The facility is staffed by certified lifeguards, possesses AEDs and emergency phones for 911 access.

Only athletes, officials, coaches, and volunteers may be on deck during warm-ups and/or competition. The 650 bleacher seats on deck are reserved for swimmers only. No chairs are permitted in the stands or on deck. Locker rooms are reserved for athlete use. Separate rest room facilities are available for officials, coaches, and volunteers.

#### **Greensboro Aquatic Center Facility Guidelines:**

Cashless: The GAC and GSO Coliseum Complex do not accept cash payments for parking, ticket sales, and concessions. A debit/credit card will be required for payment. Contactless and mobile payment options, including Apple Pay, Google Pay, and Samsung Pay, will be accepted at most payment terminals.

Spectator Bag Policy: Athletes and Coaches are allowed to bring in their bags and do not have to abide by the above policy. Spectators are only permitted to bring one small bag that meets the following guidelines:

- Clear Vinyl or Plastic Bag (no larger than 12"x6"x12")
- Clear Vinyl or Plastic Backpack (no larger than 12"x6"x12")
- Small Clutch Bag (no larger than 4.5"x6.5")
- Medical Bags\* (no larger than 12"x6"x12")
- Diaper Bags\* (no larger than 12"x6"x12")
- One-Gallon Clear Plastic Storage Bag

\*Medical bags, including diaper bags when accompanied by a child, will be inspected, and tagged before entry. *Please note this is not a comprehensive list. The GAC reserves the right to deny any bag at any time on a case-by-case basis.*

#### **VENUE SHOPS**

Augusta Swim Supply will be open at the GAC during the meet and Find Designs will be on-location to offer meet-specific apparel. Food and drink may be purchased from the concession stand located in the facility. **No outside food or drink will be permitted in the Spectator area.**

#### **PARKING**

Parking will be \$5.00 per day with re-entry allowed. Parking for Coaches, Officials, and Volunteers will be provided.

**RULES** This meet will be conducted in accordance with the current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, except where rules therein are optional and exceptions are stated.

**MAAPP** All applicable adults participating in, or associated with, the meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy (MAAPP) and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

**SAFE SPORT** The NCS Safety Program is in effect for this meet. Coaches are advised to closely always supervise their swimmers. No running or horseplay will be tolerated. Swimmers may be dropped off only in designated safe areas.

Swimmers are not permitted in workout rooms, storage areas, meeting rooms, or control rooms.

No glass containers or bottles are allowed inside the facility at any time.

Anyone failing to comply with a safety request may forfeit their privilege to participate.

**Use of audio or visual recording or photography devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms, locker rooms, or behind the starting blocks.** Flash photography of any kind is prohibited at the start of a race.

**Deck changes are prohibited.**

Any swimmer entering the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without using a backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. It is also the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's guardian to request assignment from the Meet Director to a USA Swimming member-coach attending the meet if a coach from the swimmer's team is unable to attend.

Unless approved in writing in advance of the competition by the Program and Events Committee Chair or designee, operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, spectator areas, and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.

Only swimmers, properly certified officials and coaches, and meet volunteers will be allowed on deck. No spectators will be allowed on deck at any time. All persons on deck or behind the blocks must be USAS certified coaches, officials, registered swimmers, or meet volunteers.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming, Inc., and all Adult Athletes must hold current APT certification to compete. Swimmers must be registered prior to entry deadline. Entries listed as "Registration Applied For" will not be accepted. **There will be no on-deck registration available at this meet.**

#### **TECHNICAL SUIT BAN FOR 12&U**

**Per USA Swimming rule 102.8.1F, 12 & Under athletes may not compete in Technical Suits at this meet.**

A Technical Suit is one that has the following components:

- Any male or female suit with bonded or taped seams regardless of fabric or silhouette; or
- Any male or female suit with woven fabric extending to the knee or mid-thigh regardless of the seam type.

#### **SWIMMERS WITH DISABILITIES**

Enfinity Aquatic Club welcomes all swimmers with disabilities as described in the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 105, to participate in our meets.

Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodation are required to provide advance notice in writing to the Meet Director by the Entry Deadline accompanying their meet entry file, including the need for any personal assistants required and/or registered service animals. Failure to provide advance notice may limit Enfinity Aquatic Club's ability to accommodate all requests. To request accommodation or modification for swimmers with disabilities, coaches should complete the [USA Swimming Accommodation](#) Form and submit it to the Meet Director and Meet Referee prior to the Entry Deadline.

## **ENTRIES**

**Please email entries to [bpenner@enfinityfit.com](mailto:bpenner@enfinityfit.com) using Hy-Tek Team Manager for entries. List all swimmer's ages as of May 15, 2026.** Entries may be sent via email and must include the following:

1. A Hy-Tek compatible entry file
2. Team Entry Report
3. Financial Report
4. List of Coaches Attending the Meet

**A swimmer's age on the first day of the meet will determine their age for the entire meet.**

Teams/entries will be accepted in the order they are received, until the 4-Hour timeline is reached. Entries received after the timeline is reached will be returned. **If you plan to attend this meet, please notify the Meet Director with your intent and approximate number of swimmers as soon as possible.**

## **ENTRY LIMITS**

Swimmers may swim a maximum of 3 individual events per day. The 400 Freestyle and the 400 IM may be limited to the first 48 swimmers entered in the meet. Sessions may be modified to meet the 4-Hour Rule.

## **ENTRY VERIFICATION**

An email will be sent to the person submitting the entries confirming receipt of the entries within 48 hours of receipt.

## **ENTRY DEADLINES**

**The Meet Entry Coordinator must receive entries by 7:00pm on Tuesday, May 5, 2026.** Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Meet Director and Meet Referee. Double fees will apply to all late entries and must be paid before entry. There will be no on deck entries.

**SEEDING** The conforming time standard for this meet is Long Course Meters. Swimmers will be seeded and swim from slowest to fastest for all events, except for the 400 IM and 400 Freestyle (Friday PM), which will swim fastest to slowest. All non-conforming times will be seeded last in rank order.

**POSITIVE CHECK-IN** A Positive Check-In will be required for the following Session 1 (Friday PM) events:

- Open 400 Free
- 12 & Under 200 IM
- Open 400 IM

**Positive Check-In for these events will close at 4:45 PM, 45 minutes prior to session start to scratch, seed, and produce Meet Programs.** Swimmers that fail to check-in will be scratched from the event and not seeded. In the Positive Check-In events, a swimmer who has checked in, been seeded, and fails to compete in said event, shall be barred from their next Individual Event unless excused by the Meet Referee.

**SCRATCHES** There will be no penalty for scratching pre-seeded events at the block.

**SCORING** This meet will not be scored.

**AWARDS** There will be no awards at this meet.

**RESULTS** Results will be posted to NCS Swimming within 24 hours of the meets' conclusion and sent to all teams via email attachment.

**COACHES** All coaches on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming. Meet Management will require all coaches to show proof of such by prominently displaying their registration card or be prepared to show their Virtual Membership Card upon request. There will be a Coaches/General Meeting at the date and time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. Other meetings may be held at the Meet Referee's discretion. Meet Management requests that at least one coach representative from each team attend all coaches' meetings.

**OFFICIALS/ VOLUNTEERS** There will be a need for officials. Enfinity Aquatic Club welcomes and encourages anyone willing to volunteer to contact the Meet Referee by email prior to the meet

or sign in once you arrive at the meet. All officials on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming and will be required to show proof of such to the Meet Referee by displaying their registration card or be prepared to show their virtual membership card upon request. Any official's assistance will be greatly appreciated and will help to ensure a great meet for the swimmers.

**HOSPITALITY**

There will be a hospitality area open to all coaches and officials.

**WARM-UP**

In accordance with USA Swimming guidelines, there will be a published warm-up procedure for all swimmers and coaches attending the meet. The Marshalls will ensure all teams, coaches, and swimmers follow all warm-up procedures. Meet Management reserves the right to change warm-up times according to the number of entries. During the competition, there will be lanes available for continuous warm-up/cool-down. There is no diving or horseplay in this area. Only feet-first entry into the warm-up lanes is permitted.

As a team entered in this meet, upon entry you are verifying that all the swimmers and coaches listed on the enclosed entry are registered with USA Swimming.
