FACILITY

The Greensboro Aquatics Center is a 50-meter pool which can be broken into two short course venues with a separate diving well. This competition will use the long course competition venue that is 8 lanes with continuous warm-up and cool-down lanes available throughout the meet in the short course training pool. The pool depth is 9'-10' at the start and turn ends and 4" lane lines will be used to reduce turbulence. The lane width is 7'. An Omega timing system with a Daktronics ProStar LED Video Scoreboard Display will display results simultaneously. Starting platforms are Omega deck anchored platforms. Prior to each session of competition, the facility host shall examine the bulkhead and shall confirm to the Meet Referee that the bulkhead is stable, straight and properly positioned and anchored. EAC will ensure proper course dimensions. The facility is staffed by certified lifeguards, possesses AEDs and emergency phones for 911 access.

Only athletes, officials, coaches, and meet volunteers may be on deck during warm-ups and/or competition. No one on the USA Swimming banned list is allowed to participate. The 650 bleacher seats on deck are reserved for swimmers only. No outside chairs are permitted in the stands or on deck. Locker rooms are reserved for athlete use. Separate rest room facilities are available for officials, coaches, and volunteers.

Parking will be available for up to \$5.00 per vehicle

All spectators must comply with the Greensboro Coliseum Complex Bag Policy:
Permitted Bags - Clear Bags: Clear vinyl or plastic bags, one-gallon Ziploc-style storage bags, and clear vinyl or plastic backpacks, measuring no larger than 12" x 6" x 12". Small Clutch Bags: Small bags up to 4.5" x 6.5" (approximately the size of a hand), with or without a handle or strap, do not have to be clear.

Medical Bags: Medical bags, including diaper bags when accompanied by a child, will be inspected before entry.

Greensboro Coliseum Complex personnel reserve the right to deny entry to any bag or item that is deemed unsafe for admission. Guests who do not follow building policies or decline to be inspected may be denied entry or required to leave the venue. Greensboro Coliseum Complex does not provide a bag check or lockers for bags. All bags left in lobbies/hallways will be discarded.

No outside food or drink is permitted in the facility. No coolers are allowed in the facility.

RULES

This meet will be conducted in accordance with the current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, except where rules therein are optional, and exceptions are stated.

- The referee and meet management reserve the right to combine heats, events and/or sessions as well as restrict the number of heats to adhere to the timeline.
- Deck entries (only to fill empty lanes) will be taken until 30 minutes prior to the start of the session.

TECHNICAL SUIT BAN for 12&Us

Per USA Swimming Rule 102.8.1F, 12 & Under athletes may not compete in Technical Suits at this meet.

A Technical Suit is one that has the following components:

- Any male or female suit with bonded or taped seams regardless of fabric or silhouette; or
- Any male or female suit with woven fabric extending to the knee or mid-thigh regardless of the seam type.

MAAPP

All adults participating in or associated with the meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy (“MAAPP”), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

SAFE SPORT

The NCS Safety Program is in effect for this meet. Coaches are advised to closely supervise their swimmers at all times. Swimmers may be dropped off only in designated safe areas. Swimmers are not permitted in work out rooms, storage rooms, meeting rooms, or control rooms. No glass containers or bottles are allowed inside the facility at any time. Anyone failing to comply with a safety request may forfeit his or her privilege to participate. We strongly recommend each team assign a marshal to monitor warm-up sessions and locker rooms in addition to host team marshal.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, locker rooms, or behind the starting blocks. Flash photography of any kind is prohibited at the start of a race.

Deck changes are prohibited.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of a backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. It is also the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s guardian to request assignment from the Meet Director to a USA Swimming member coach attending the meet if a coach from the swimmer’s team is unable to attend.

Unless approved in writing in advance of the competition by the Program and Events Committee Chair or designee, operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, spectator areas, and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.

Only swimmers, properly certified officials and coaches, and meet volunteers will be allowed on deck. No spectators will be allowed on deck at any time.

ELIGIBILITY

All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming, Inc. and all Adult Athletes must hold current APT certification to compete. Swimmers must be registered prior to the entry deadline. Entries listed as “Registration Applied For” will not be accepted. THERE WILL BE NO ON DECK REGISTRATION AVAILABLE AT THIS MEET.

**MEMBERS WITH
DISABILITIES OR
MEDICAL CONDITIONS**

Enfinity Aquatic Club welcomes all swimmers with disabilities as described in the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 105, to participate in our meets. Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations are required to provide advance notice in writing to the Meet Director by the entry deadline accompanying their meet entry file, including the need for any personal assistants required and/or registered service animals. Failure to provide advance notice may limit Enfinity Aquatic Club’s ability to accommodate all requests. To request accommodation or modification for swimmers with disabilities, coaches should complete the [USA Swimming Accommodation Form](#) and submit it to the Meet Referee and Meet Director prior to the entry deadline.

ENTRIES

Please email entries to kmcculleygso@enfinityfit.com using Hy-Tek Team Manager for entries. List all swimmers' ages as of May 16, 2025. Entries may be sent via email and must include the following:

- 1) A Hy-Tek compatible entry file
- 2) Team entry report
- 3) Financial report
- 4) A list of Coaches attending the meet.

Entries submitted in Hy-tek format require no hard copy entry forms. Email is preferred for electronic entries. A completed and signed Entry Summary Sheet and payment in full must be received by the Meet Entry Coordinator by the start of the meet. A swimmer's age on the first day of the meet will determine their age for the entire meet. Enfinity Aquatic Club's entries will be entered first and then accept teams/entries in the order received, until the four-hour rule is reached. Entries received thereafter will be returned immediately.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS

Swimmers may swim a maximum of **3** individual events per day. 400 Freestyle and 400 IM may be limited to first 48 swimmers entered in the meet. Sessions may be modified to meet the 4-hour rule.

ENTRY VERIFICATION

An email will be sent to the person submitting the entry confirming receipt of the entry within 48 hours of receipt.

ENTRY DEADLINES

The Meet Entry Coordinator must receive entries by the date and time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Meet Referee at twice the cost. There will be no on deck entries.

SEEDING

The conforming time standard for this meet is long course meters. Swimmers will be seeded and swim from slowest to fastest for all events, with the exception of the 400 IM and 400 Fr (Friday pm), which will swim fastest to slowest. All non-conforming times will be seeded last in rank order.

CHECK-IN

A positive check-in, at the clerk of course, will be required for the following events: Open 400 Free, 12&U 200 IM, & Open 400 IM. Check in for event will be 45 minutes prior to session start to scratch, seed, and produce meet programs. Swimmers that fail to check in will be scratched from the event and not seeded. In the positive check-in events, a swimmer who has checked in, been seeded, and fails to compete in said event, shall be barred from his/her next individual event unless excused by the Meet Referee.

SCRATCHES

There will be no penalty for scratching pre-seeded events at the block.

SCORING

This meet will not be scored.

AWARDS

There will be no awards at this meet.

RESULTS	Results will be posted to NCS Swimming within 24 hours of the meet's conclusion and sent to all teams via email attachment.
COACHES	All coaches on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming. Meet Management will require all coaches to show proof of such by prominently displaying their registration card or be prepared to show their Deck Pass virtual membership card upon request. There will be a coach/general meeting at the date and time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. Other meetings may be held at the meet referee's discretion. Meet Management requests that at least one coach representative from each team attend all coaches' meetings.
OFFICIALS/TIMERS/ VOLUNTEERS	<p>Teams will be required to provide volunteer times in proportion to the number of swimmers they have entered in each session. Specific numbers required per team will be distributed 48 hours after the entry deadline.</p> <p>There will be a need for officials. Enfinity Aquatic Club welcomes and encourages anyone willing to volunteer. Volunteering Officials MUST contact the Meet Referee by email prior to the meet. All officials on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming. Certification will be verified by Meet Referee the day before the meet / session. An officials meeting will be held 45min prior to the start of each session (at the referee's discretion), and all assigned officials are strongly encouraged to complete an individual personal review of applicable USAS rules for their assigned position prior to the meet.</p>
HOSPITALITY/ CONCESSIONS WARM-UP	<p>Hospitality open to coaches and officials. Refreshments available at the concession stand.</p> <p>In accordance with USA Swimming guidelines, there will be a published warm-up procedure for all swimmers and coaches attending the meet. The Marshall will ensure all teams, coaches, and swimmers follow all warm-up procedures. Meet Management reserves the right to change warm-up times according to the number of entries. During the competition, there will be lanes available for continuous warm-up/down (if available). There is to be no diving or horseplay in this area.</p>
