## FACILITY

The SwimMAC Swim Center is a 30,000-square-foot facility featuring a 50-meter by 25-yard Paddock Pool racing tank. The pool has Competitor 4" Racing Lanes and uses Paddock stainless steel starting platforms. The facility also features a Colorado System 6 timing system and a ten-lane scoreboard. Touchpads, buttons, and two watches per lane will be used. Hy-Tek Meet Manager software will be used. In the 50-yard competition configuration (Prelims/Timed Finals), the pool depth ranges from 12 feet at the starting end to 4 feet at the pool's far end with ten (10), 8-foot-wide lanes. Eight (8) lanes will be used for competition during all Preliminary and Timed Final sessions. Lane ten (10) will be available for continuous warm-up/cool-down during the competition. SwimMAC will work with the facility to ensure the required course dimensions are valid. Lifeguards will provide First Aid. Available equipment includes an AED, backboard, bag-valve Mask, and one-way valve mask.

Klein Aquatics Center (KAC) is a 5,625-square-foot pool area featuring a 25-yard by 25-yard competition tank. The pool depth ranges from 7 feet at the starting end to 7'-3" at the pool's far end with eight 9-foot-wide lanes with TSP Wave Breaker 6" lane lines. Kiefer starting blocks will be used for competition in accordance with the

USA Swimming diving depth guidelines. The facility also features a Colorado 7 timing system and a full-color eight-lane scoreboard. The timing system utilizes touch pads, two buttons, and two watches per lane. Hy-Tek Meet Manager software will be used. An adjacent 25-yard 5-lane program pool is available for continuous warm-up and cool-down. SwimMAC will work with the facility to ensure the required course dimensions are valid. Lifeguards will provide First Aid. Available equipment includes an AED, backboard, bag-valve Mask, and one-way valve mask.

Spectator seating is in a separate gallery only. No chairs are permitted on the deck for spectators. Parking is available on weekends in the Student Parking Lot 100 yards east of the facility. Smoking is not permitted inside the building. No glass bottles will be allowed on the pool deck. Only meet volunteers, USA Swimming registered athletes, current USA Swimming registered officials, and coaches may be on the deck. Separate locker rooms and public restrooms are available.

## MEET FORMAT

Prelim/finals pre-seeded meet, unless otherwise indicated, with Qualifying Times.

Saturday and Sunday Prelims – Prelims will be swum using eight (8) lanes in a **Long Course format @ SwimMAC Training Facility – Charlotte Latin**.

Saturday and Sunday Finals—The finals will be swum using eight (8) lanes in a Short Course format, with a maximum of eight (8) lanes at Klein Aquatics Center.

Events **200 M or less** will be swum using A, B, C, and D format; The top 22 qualifiers will return for Finals. The D Bonus and C Consolation Finals will swim using eight (8) lanes. The B Super Finals will use four (4) lanes, and the A Ultra Final will use two (2) lanes. Final heats will swim in the following order: D, C, B, and A Final.

The **400IM** and **400M/500y** Freestyle will be swum using the A, B, and C format. The top 20 qualifiers will return for the Finals. The C Bonus and B Consolation Final will swim using eight (8) lanes, and the A Championship Final will use four (4) lanes. Final heats will swim in the following order: C, B, and A.

During preliminary rounds, the **800 M/1000 Yard Freestyle** will be limited to two heats for Women and two for men. The top eight women and the top eight men will return for the finals.

Meet management reserves the right to limit heats or eliminate events if needed to manage the timeline. Teams will be notified within 48 hours after entries close of any event limitations. Meet Management reserves the right to add breaks between events if deemed necessary. Breaks will be published before the session and limited to 10 minutes. Events may be combined at the discretion of the Referee. All events will swim slowest to fastest unless noted.

### RULES

**This meet will be conducted in accordance with the current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, except where rules therein are optional, and exceptions are stated.**

### TECHNICAL SUIT BAN for 12&Us

**Per USA Swimming Rule 102.8.1F, 12 & Under athletes may not compete in Technical Suits at this meet.**

A Technical Suit is one that has the following components:

- Any male or female suit with bonded or taped seams regardless of fabric or silhouette; or
- Any male or female suit with woven fabric extending to the knee or mid-thigh regardless of the seam type.

### MAAPP

All applicable adults participating in or associated with the meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy ("MAAPP") and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

### SAFE SPORT

The NCS Safety Program is in effect for this meet. Coaches are advised to closely always supervise their swimmers. Swimmers may be dropped off only in designated safe areas. Swimmers are not permitted in workout rooms, storage rooms, meeting rooms, or control rooms. No glass containers or bottles are allowed inside the facility at any time. Anyone failing to comply with a safety request may forfeit his or her privilege to participate. We strongly recommend each team assign a marshal to monitor warm-up sessions and locker rooms in addition to the host team marshal.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms, locker rooms, or behind the starting blocks. Flash photography of any kind is prohibited at the start of a race.

Deck changes are prohibited.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of a backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member -coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. It is also the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's guardian to request an assignment from the Meet Director to a USA Swimming member coach attending the meet if a coach from the swimmer's team is unable to attend.

Unless approved in writing in advance of the competition by the Program and Events Committee Chair or designee, operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is

prohibited over the venue (pools, spectator areas, and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.

Only swimmers, properly certified officials, coaches, and meet volunteers will be allowed on deck. No spectators will be allowed on deck at any time.

#### ELIGIBILITY

All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming, Inc. All Adult Athletes must hold current APT certification to compete. Swimmers must be registered prior to the entry deadline. Entries listed as "Registration Applied For" will not be accepted. **There will be no on-deck registration available at this meet.**

#### MEMBERS WITH DISABILITIES OR MEDICAL CONDITIONS

SwimMAC welcomes all swimmers with disabilities as described in the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 105, to participate in our meets. Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations are required to provide advance notice in writing to the Meet Director by the entry deadline, accompanying their meet entry file, including the need for any personal assistants required and/or registered service animals. Failure to provide advance notice may limit SwimMAC's ability to accommodate all requests. To request accommodation or modification for swimmers with disabilities, coaches should complete the [USA Swimming Accommodation Form](#) and submit it to the Meet Referee and Meet Director prior to the entry deadline

#### ENTRIES

Entries submitted in Hy-tek format require no hard copy entry forms. Email must be emailed to the Meet Entry Coordinator by the entry deadline. A completed and signed Entry Summary Sheet (included in the announcement) and payment in full must be received by the Meet Entry Coordinator by the entry deadline. A swimmer's age on the first day of the meet will determine their age for the entire meet. SwimMAC entries will be entered first, and accepted teams/entries will be entered in the order received.

#### BONUS EVENTS

Swimmers qualifying in any individual event by having a 2025 North Carolina Swimming Senior Short Course Qualifying time in that event are also eligible to enter **up to three (3) bonus events**. All entries are subjected to both daily and meet limits.

#### ENTRY LIMITATIONS

Swimmers may compete in three (3) individual events per day for six (6) events for the meet.

#### ENTRY VERIFICATION

An email will be sent to the person submitting the entry confirming receipt of the entry within 48 hours of receipt.

#### ENTRY DEADLINES

**The Meet Entry Coordinator must receive entries by the date and time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. No late entries will be accepted. There will be no on-deck entries.**

## SEEDING

The conforming time standard for this meet is long course meters. All non-conforming times will be seeded in the last rank order. Events will be seeded in the following order: L.C.M., S.C.Y., L.C.M. Bonus, and S.C.Y. Bonus. Swimmers will be seeded and swum from slowest to fastest unless otherwise indicated. Preliminary events will be circled-seeded. All events 400 M and longer will be deck-seeded.

## CHECK-IN

Positive check-in will be at the Clerk of Course. There will be a positive check-in for 400-yard or longer events. Swimmers who fail to check in by the deadline will be scratched from the event. See the Schedule below:

- **Open 400M IM:** The 400M Individual Medley will be swum as a prelims/finals event and deck seeded slowest to fastest after positive check-in. The top two heats will be circled-seeded.
- **Open 800M/1000y Free:** The 800M Freestyle will be swum as a prelim/final event and deck-seeded after positive check-in. The **fastest two (2) heats** of women swim first, slow to fast, followed by the **fastest two (2) heats** of men swum slow to fast. The remaining heats will swim fast to slow, alternating women and men. Heats may be limited, or a combined Women's/Men's heat may be swum at the discretion of the Meet Referee. **1000 SCY will swim during finals.**
- **Open 400M/500y Free:** The 400M Free will be swum as a prelims/finals event and deck seeded slowest to fastest after positive check-in. The top two heats will be circled-seeded. **500 SCY will swim during finals.**

## RELAYS

## SCRATCHES

There will be no penalty for scratching pre-seeded events at the block. For positive check-in deck-seeded events, a swimmer who is properly checked in has been seeded and fails to compete in said event **shall be barred from their next individual event.**

A swimmer identified as a **finalist when preliminary results** are announced and subsequently seeded who fails to compete in said final heat **shall be barred from further competition** for the remainder of the meet unless relieved by the Meet Referee. It is the swimmer's responsibility to scratch from finals. Swimmers are requested to scratch their events regardless of place if they are not returning for Finals. **Swimmers should listen for announcements and check for scratches at the Clerk of Course desk on the pool deck.**

Coaches are asked to instruct alternates to check in with the deck referee, identifying themselves as an alternate, prior to the beginning of the event for which they are an alternate.

Results will be posted on the SwimMAC website within 24 hours of the meet's conclusion. At the conclusion of the meet, teams may obtain Hy-Tek backups either on a memory stick or via email attachment.

## COACHES

All coaches on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming. Meet Management will require all coaches to show proof of such by prominently displaying their registration card or be prepared to show their Deck Pass virtual membership card upon request. A coach/general meeting will be at the date and time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. Other meetings may be held at the meet referee's discretion. Meet Management requests that at least one coach representative from each team attend all coaches' meetings.

## OFFICIALS/TIMERS/ VOLUNTEERS

There will be a need for officials. SwimMAC welcomes and encourages anyone willing to volunteer. Volunteering Officials are encouraged to sign up using the following [link](#). If you have questions, please contact the Meet Referee Jeffrey Childs@jeffrey@rileychilds.net. All officials on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming. Certification will be verified by Meet Referee the day before the meet/session. There will be a meeting at the day(s)/time(s) listed in the "Deadline and Meeting Summary" above. Meetings may be in-person at the meet or virtual in advance, and assignments may be communicated electronically prior to each session. All officials are strongly encouraged to complete a personal review of applicable USAS rules before the meet. Officials should report at the time specified by the Meet Referee and bring a mask (if necessary) and a writing utensil.

### OFFICIALS QUALIFYING MEET (O.Q.M.)

This meet has applied as a U.S.A. Swimming Official Qualification Meet, certification, and re-certification for all **N2 positions and N3 S&T only.**

Regardless of the number of sessions required for certification/re-certification, an official must serve a minimum of four (4) sessions to be evaluated. Any official wishing to participate should use the signup sheet above, and any questions should be sent to [jeffrey@rileychilds.net](mailto:jeffrey@rileychilds.net). All requests for assigned positions will be based on evaluation requests and experience level. Please see the U.S.A. Swimming website for additional information on National evaluation and certification requirements.

#### **HOSPITALITY/ CONCESSIONS**

There will be a hospitality area open to all coaches and officials.

#### **WARM-UP**

In accordance with USA Swimming guidelines, there will be a published warm-up procedure for all swimmers and coaches attending the meet. The Marshalls will ensure all teams, coaches, and swimmers follow all warm-up procedures. Meet Management reserves the right to change warm-up times according to the number of entries. During the competition, there will be lanes available for continuous warm-up/down. **There is to be no diving or horseplay in this area.**

#### **WAIVER/RELEASE**

As a team entered in this meet, upon entry, you are verifying that all the swimmers and coaches listed on the enclosed entry are registered with USA Swimming. You acknowledge that you are familiar with the Safety Rules of USA Swimming, Inc. and North Carolina Swimming, Inc. regarding warm-up procedures and meet safety guidelines and that you shall be responsible for the compliance of your swimmers with those rules during this meet.
