LOCAL COVID PROTOCOLS	Only Meet Volunteers, Officials, Swimmers and Coaches will be permitted on deck. Masks are required for all individuals in the facility. Masks are required for anyone on the pool deck unless swimming, exiting the water, or preparing to enter the water. These protocols will be adjusted to reflect the latest capacity allowed by the Governor's Executive Order in effect at the time of the meet.	
LOCKER ROOMS/ CHANGING	Athletes are encouraged to arrive and depart in swimsuits. Locker room access will be limited.	
ENTRY & EXIT PROCEDURES and ATHLETE SEATING	Swimmers should enter the building through the main entrance and proceed to their designated spot in the classroom. Swimmers will set up their chairs in a classroom. NO CHAIRS ON THE Competition POOL DECK. SWIMMERS SHOULD ONLY BE ON THE POOL DECK TO SWIM.	
SWIMMER LIMITATIONS AND PROTOCOLSSwimmers who are not in the pool swimming, in an event, must stay in the spots and wear face coverings. Swimmers will be lined up for their respect the classroom off the pool deck. When not in the water, athletes are expected to wear a mask at all time when walking to and from an event and/or warm-up lanes. They may r for swimming but must don them again once they exit the water. Addit athletes are expected to maintain proper distancing at all times, includi warming up.		
SPECTATOR LIMITATIONS	Spectators will be permitted and must wear a mask.	
PARENTAL ACCESS FOR SAFE SPORT	Parents can watch their swimmer from the spectator area on the deck which will be limited. Should parents be unable to contact their child directly, they should seek assistance of the Meet Marshal located in the lobby or pool deck.	

FACILITY	A.E. Finley YMCA. This facility is a 10 lane, 25-yard pool with depths ranging from 3.5 – 10 feet.
	We will be using KDI Paragon starting platforms and a Colorado semi-automatic timing system.
	The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). There will be no
	changing rooms for competitors. Locker rooms are not allowed to be used for showering and
	changed. Per USA Swimming and Safe Sport Rules, ONLY USA Swimming registered athletes,
	current USA Swimming registered officials and coaches may be on deck during warm-ups and/or
	competition. ALL coaches, officials, and meet personnel will be required to wear wristbands or
	lanyards on the pool deck. Please check-in at the clerk of course.

TECHNICAL SUIT BAN for 12&Us	Per USA Swimming Rule 102.8.1F, 12 & Under athletes may not compete in Technical Suits at this meet.	
	 A Technical Suit is one that has the following components: Any male or female suit with bonded or taped seams regardless of fabric or silhouette; or Any male or female suit with woven fabric extending to the knee or mid-thigh regardless of the seam type. 	
МААРР	All applicable adults participating in or associated with the meet acknowledge that they ar subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.	
SAFE SPORT	The NCS Safety Program is in effect for this meet. Coaches are advised to closely supervise their swimmers at all times. Swimmers may be dropped off only in designated safe areas. Swimmers are not permitted in work out rooms, storage rooms, meeting rooms, or control rooms. No glass containers or bottles are allowed inside the facility at any time. Anyone failing to comply with a safety request may forfeit his or her privilege to participate. We strongly recommend each team assign a marshal to monitor warm-up sessions and locker rooms in addition to the host team marshal.	
	The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, locker rooms, or behind the starting blocks. Flash photography of any kind is prohibited at the start of a race. Deck changes are prohibited.	

	Any swimmer entered in the meet who is unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. It is also the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's guardian to request an assignment from the Meet Director to a USA Swimming member coach attending the meet if a coach from the swimmer's team is unable to attend. Unless approved in writing in advance of the competition by the Program and Events
	Committee Chair or designee, operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, spectator areas, and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.
	Only swimmers, properly certified officials and coaches, and meet volunteers will be allowed on deck. No spectators will be allowed on deck at any time.
ELIGIBILITY	All swimmers must be YOTA Swim Team members registered with USA Swimming, Inc. and all Adult Athletes must hold current APT certification to compete. Swimmers must be registered prior to the entry deadline. Entries listed as "Registration Applied For" will not be accepted. There will be no on-deck registration available at this meet.
MEMBERS WITH DISABILITIES OR MEDICAL CONDITIONS	YOTA Swim Team welcomes all swimmers with disabilities as described in the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 105, to participate in our meets. Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations are required to provide advance notice in writing to the Meet Director by the entry deadline accompanying their meet entry file, including the need for any personal assistants required and/or registered service animals. Members who are unable to wear face coverings because of a documented medical condition must notify the Meet Director in advance and may have limited deck access. Failure to provide advance notice may limit The YOTA Swim Team's ability to accommodate all requests.
ENTRIES Entries submitted in Hy-tek format require no hard copy entry forms. Email is prefe electronic entries, however; disks are also acceptable. A completed and signed Entr Summary Sheet (included in the announcement) and payment in full must be receive the Meet Entry Coordinator by the entry deadline. A swimmer's age on the first day meet will determine their age for the entire meet. HOST TEAMS entries will be ente and then accept teams/entries in the order received, until the four/eight-hour rule i reached. Entries received thereafter will be returned immediately.	
ENTRY LIMITATIONS	Swimmers may swim a maximum of 4 individual events. No relays at this meet.
ENTRY VERIFICATION	An email will be sent to the person submitting the entry confirming receipt of the entry within 48 hours of receipt.

ENTRY DEADLINES	NES The Meet Entry Coordinator must receive entries by the date and time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. No late entries will be accepted. There will be no o deck entries OR late entries.	
ENTRY FEES	No entries fees.	
SEEDING	The conforming time standard for this meet is short course yards. Swimmers will be seeded and swim from slowest to fastest unless otherwise indicated. All non-conforming times will be seeded last in rank order	
CHECK-IN	There are no positive check-in events in this meet.	
SCRATCHES	There will be no penalty for scratching pre-seeded events at the block.	
SCORING	This meet will not be scored.	
AWARDS	There will be no awards at this meet.	
RESULTS	Results will be posted within 24 hours of the conclusion of the meet. At the conclusion of the meet, teams may obtain Hy-tek backups either on a memory stick or via email attachment.	
COACHES	All coaches on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming. Meet Management will require all coaches to show proof of such by prominently displaying thei registration card or be prepared to show their Deck Pass virtual membership card upon request. There will be a coach/general meeting at the date and time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. Other meetings may be held at the meet referee's discretion. Meet Management requests that at least one coach representative from each team attend all coaches' meetings.

	coaches, and swimmers follow all warm-up procedures. Meet Management reserves the right to change warm-up times according to the number of entries. During the competition, there will be lanes available for continuous warm-up/down (if available). There is to be no diving or horseplay in this area.	
WAIVER/RELEASE	As a team entered in this meet, upon entry you are verifying that all of the swimmers and coaches listed on the enclosed entry are registered with USA Swimming. You acknowledge that you are familiar with the Safety Rules of USA Swimming, Inc. and North Carolina Swimming, Inc. regarding warm-up procedures and meet safety guidelines and that you shall be responsible for the compliance of your swimmers with those rules during this meet.
