FACILITY
The Greensboro Aquatics Center is a state-of-the-art indoor facility with four pools, which opened in August 2011. The main competition pool is 9-10 feet deep at both ends and will be configured into one 50 meter course with eight 9 -foot-wide lanes. All lanes feature non-turbulent lane lines and KD Paragon starting blocks with Omega track start tops. The Omega electronic timing system will be used.

SwimGSA will ensure the required competition course dimensions. Prior to each session of competition, the facility host shall examine the bulkhead and shall confirm to the Meet Referee that the bulkhead is stable, straight, properly positioned, and anchored.

Seating for 1800 spectators is available. Parking will be available at the Coliseum for up to $\$ 5$ per day with unlimited entry and exit. Free parking will be provided for participating certified coaches and officials. Outside chairs and outside food will not be allowed in the facility. Coolers are not allowed in the facility. GAC staff and lifeguards will provide medical support.

Only athletes, officials, coaches, and volunteers may be on deck at any time. The 650 bleacher seats on deck are reserved for swimmers only. No chairs are permitted in the stands or on deck.

Locker rooms are reserved for athlete's use. Separate rest room facilities are available for officials, coaches, and volunteers.

TECHNICAL SUIT

MAAPP

SAFE SPORT

This meet will be conducted in accordance with the current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, except where rules therein are optional, and exceptions are stated.

Per USA Swimming Rule 102.8.1F, 12 \& Under athletes may not compete in Technical Suits at this meet.

A Technical Suit is one that has the following components:

- Any male or female suit with bonded or taped seams regardless of fabric or silhouette; or
- Any male or female suit with woven fabric extending to the knee or mid-thigh regardless of the seam type.

All adults participating in or associated with the meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

The NCS Safety Program is in effect for this meet. Coaches are advised to closely supervise their swimmers at all times. Swimmers may be dropped off only in designated safe areas. Swimmers are not permitted in work out rooms, storage rooms, meeting rooms, or control rooms. No glass containers or bottles are allowed inside the facility at
any time. Anyone failing to comply with a safety request may forfeit his or her privilege to participate. We strongly recommend each team assign a marshal to monitor warmup sessions and locker rooms in addition to host team marshal.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, locker rooms, or behind the starting blocks. Flash photography of any kind is prohibited at the start of a race.

Deck changes are prohibited.

Any swimmer entered in the meet who is unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. It is also the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's guardian to request assignment from the Meet Director to a USA Swimming member coach attending the meet if a coach from the swimmer's team is unable to attend.

Unless approved in writing in advance of the competition by the Program and Events Committee Chair or designee, operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, spectator areas, and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.

Only swimmers, properly certified officials, coaches, and meet volunteers will be allowed on deck. No spectators will be allowed on deck at any time.

## ELIGIBILITY

MEMBERS WITH DISABILITIES OR MEDICAL CONDITIONS

## ENTRIES

All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming, Inc. and Adult Athletes must hold current APT certification to compete. Swimmers must be registered prior to entry deadline. Entries listed as "Registration Applied For" will not be accepted. There will be no on-deck registration available at this meet.

Swimmer's age on the first day of the meet will determine his age for the entire meet. Swimmers must be at least $\mathbf{8}$ years old to enter.

13\&O events are OPEN events. 12-year-old swimmers may elect to swim in the OPEN events but are then not eligible to swim in any 12\&U events and will be seeded with the $17 \& 0$ age group for finals.

SwimGSA welcomes all swimmers with disabilities as described in the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 105, to participate in this meet. Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations are required to provide advance notice in writing to the Meet Director by the entry deadline accompanying their meet entry file, including the need for any personal assistants required and/or registered service animals. Failure to provide advance notice may limit SwimGSA's ability to accommodate all requests.

Entries shall be submitted in Hy-Tek format via email to Meet Entry Coordinator. The completed and signed Entry Summary Sheet (included in the announcement) and payment in full must be received before the swim meet. A swimmer's age on the first day of the meet will determine their age for the entire meet. HOST TEAM entries will be entered first and then the visiting teams.

Swimmers may enter up to ten (10) individual events for the meet. OPEN swimmers may swim a maximum of three (3) individual events per day and $12 \& U$ swimmers in the afternoon sessions are limited to four (4) individual events per day.

Meet Management reserves the right to limit $12 \& U$ entries to comply with the 4-hour rule and to manage session/meet timelines.

The $13 \& 0400 \mathrm{M}$ Freestyle and 400 M IM may be limited to the Top $32-48$ by gender to manage morning timelines. The 9-12 400M Freestyle may be limited to the Top 32. Swimmers who enter these 400M events but are not allowed to swim will be accommodated in other events if possible or may request an entry fee refund. Coaches will be notified once entries close.

Only LCM times will be accepted for entries. Swimmers without actual LCM times should be entered with converted SCY times or estimated LCM times to assure best seeding for all competitors. NT entries will not be accepted.

ENTRY An email will be sent to the person submitting the entry confirming receipt of the VERIFICATION

## ENTRY DEADLINES

The Meet Entry Coordinator must receive entries by the date and time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. No late entries will be accepted. There will be no on deck entries.

SEEDING The conforming time standard for this meet is LCM (long course meters). All 13\&O preliminary events will be seeded and swum from SLOWEST TO FASTEST unless otherwise indicated or the decision is made to use chase starts. Swim GSA reserves the right to use chase starts or to combine heats and events at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

- 8-12 and 9-12 Timed Finals Events: All events for 8-12 swimmers will be swum as timed finals in the afternoons. All events will swim SLOWEST TO FASTEST unless otherwise indicated. Individual event results will be split by 8-10/11-12 for 8-12 events and by 9-10/11-12 for 9-12 events for scoring and awards.
- 13\&O Prelim/Finals Events: All prelim heats will swim SLOWEST TO FASTEST. Preliminary results will be divided into 13-14, 15-16, and 17\&O for finals seeding. There will be $A / B$ Finals for each age group. The $A$ Final will be swum before the $B$ Final. Finals will be swum in event order: 13-14 A Final/B Final, 15-16 A Final/B Final, then $17 \& 0$ A Final/B Final. There is not a ready room. All finalists should report to the blocks. Alternates should report to the Starter prior to the event and may swim in the B Final for their age group in the event of no shows.
- 13\&O 1500M Free: The 1500M Freestyle will be swum as a timed final, FASTEST TO SLOWEST, alternating women and men. The event will be deck seeded after positive check-in. Heats and events may be combined at the discretion of the Meet Referee. Swimmers must provide one timer and a counter. This event will not be broken out by age for scoring or awards.
- 13\&O 800M Free: The 800M Freestyle will be swum as a timed final, FASTEST TO SLOWEST, alternating women and men. The event will be deck seeded after positive check-in. If chase starts are used, women will start from one end and men from the other. Heats and events may be combined at the discretion of the Meet Referee. Swimmers must provide one timer and a counter. This event will not be broken out by age for scoring or awards.
- 13\&0 400M IM: The 13\&0 400M Individual Medley will be swum as a timed final event and will be deck seeded after positive check in. At a minimum, the fastest 16 positively checked in swimmers in each event will swim with finals, FASTEST TO SLOWEST, in event order. Meet Management reserves the right to swim additional heats at night in order to manage the morning session's timeline. Coaches will be informed prior to positive check-in how many swimmers will compete at night. Remaining heats will swim at the end of preliminaries, FASTEST TO SLOWEST, in event order. Heats and events may be combined at the discretion of the Meet Referee. No AM/PM option will be offered. Swimmers may be asked to provide a timer during prelims. The event will be broken out by age group for scoring and awards.
- 13\&0 400M Free: The 13\&0 400M Freestyle will be swum as a timed final event and will be deck seeded after positive check in. At a minimum, the fastest 16 positively checked in swimmers in each event will swim with finals, FASTEST TO SLOWEST, in event order. Meet Management reserves the right to swim additional heats at night in order to manage the morning session's timeline. Coaches will be informed prior to positive check-in how many swimmers will compete at night. Remaining heats will swim at the end of preliminaries, FASTEST TO SLOWEST in event order. Heats and events may be combined at the discretion of the Meet Referee. No AM/PM option will be offered. Swimmers may be asked to provide a timer during prelims. The event will be broken out by age group for scoring and awards.
- 9-12 400M Free: The 9-12 400M Freestyle will be swum SLOWEST TO FASTEST in event order. The event will be deck seeded after positive check-in and may be limited to the top 32. Heats and events may be combined at the discretion of the Meet Referee. Swimmers may be asked to provide a timer.
- RELAYS: All 8-12 relays will be swum as timed finals in the afternoon sessions. All $13 \& 0$ relays will be swum as timed finals in the evening sessions. No AM/PM option will be offered.

WARM-UP

For positive check in deck seeded events, a swimmer who is properly checked in, been seeded, and fails to complete in said event, shall be barred from their next individual event unless the swimmer declares a false start prior to the heat or the Meet Referee accepts that the swimmer's failure to compete was caused by illness, injury, or factors beyond the swimmer's control.

For all finals events, a swimmer identified as a finalist when preliminary results are announced who fails to compete in said final heat shall be barred from his next individual event unless he declared intent to scratch within 30 minutes of the results announcement or the Meet Referee accepts that the swimmer's failure to compete was caused by illness, injury, or factors beyond the swimmer's control.

Alternates should report to the starter prior to the event and will swim in the B Final for their age group if no shows occur.

Individual and relay events will score points as follows:

- Individual events top 16: 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1
- Relay events score double
$8-10 / 9-10$, and 11-12: $1^{\text {st }}-3^{\text {rd }}$ medals; $4^{\text {th }}-8^{\text {th }}$ ribbons
$13-14,15-16$, and 17\&O: $1^{\text {st }}-3^{\text {rd }}$ medals
Relays: $1^{\text {st }}$ medal; $2^{\text {nd }}-3^{\text {rd }}$ ribbons
Results will be posted on Meet Mobile during the meet. At the conclusion of the meet, teams will be e-mailed a results file.

In accordance with USA Swimming guidelines, there will be a published warm-up procedure for all swimmers and coaches attending the meet. The marshal will ensure all teams, coaches, and swimmers follow all warm-up procedures. There is to be no diving or horseplay in this area.

Meet Management will require all coaches to show proof of such by prominently displaying their registration card or be prepared to show their virtual membership card upon request. There will be a coach/general meeting at the date and time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. Other meetings may be held at the meet referee's discretion. Meet Management requests that at least one coach representative from each team attend all coaches' meetings.

SwimGSA welcomes and encourages anyone willing to volunteer to contact the Meet Referee by email prior to the meet or sign in upon arrival at the meet. All officials on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming. The Meet Referee will require all officials to show proof of such by prominently displaying their registration card or be prepared to show their virtual membership card upon request. The official mobile application of USA Swimming is acceptable proof of USA Swimming membership.

A certification card showing the official's level of certification must also be presented. Any official's assistance will be greatly appreciated and will help to ensure a great meet for the swimmers.

Official briefings will be held 45 minutes prior to the start of each session in the hospitality area.

SwimGSA requests visiting teams provide volunteer timers, in proportion to the number of each team's swimmers attending the swim meet. A timers' meeting will be held approximately 30 minutes prior to the start of each session.

Hospitality is open to all coaches, officials, and administrators. Refreshments will be for sale at concession stands. GAC does not permit outside food.

All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the host club approved photographer(s) and videographers and to allow the right to use names and pictures before, during, or after the meet such as in public psych sheets, heat sheets, and results or featured on the host club or NCS website or social media or in public broadcast of the event via television or webcast. Parents and guardians of minor swimmers who do not wish their swimmers to participate in interviews or have individual pictures featured on any media should inform their team's head coach and the Meet Director prior to the meet.
