- 3. Reading, correction and adoption of minutes –Lisa Olack
  - MOTION: Approve August 30, 2017, minutes PASSED
- 4. Officer Reports
  - a) General Chair Dave Olack
    - i) Thanks to all who attended convention; NCS was well represented
    - ii) April 2018, USA Swimming conducting an athlete workshop in Houston; they will assist in funding 1 ½ athletes and 1 coach. Athlete committee will identify the selection process for athletes and Jay will identify the coach candidates for this workshop
  - b) Treasurer Jon Fox
    - i) Balance Sheet good shape
    - ii) Income Statement convention/LSC meeting contains 2 conventions due to timing of them in the fiscal period
  - c) Finance Carl Labonge
    - i) Budget shows a 3% increase in income per line item; we will be close to \$1 million in revenue, \$975,000; expenses has an increase of 4% per line item.
    - ii) Dave explained the \$10K for Water Safety and Diversity is to host approximately 7 clinics across the state to teach water safety to kids
    - iii) MOTION: To approve budget to present to HOD PASSED

- i) Early numbers show registered members 2791; 2673 athletes, 73 coaches, 28 officials
- ii) OMS (Online Member Services) plans to go live in February 2018
- iii) Flex Membership available as an option to LSCs
- c) Governance Committee Wayne Shulby
  - i) MOTION: To appoint Richard Pockat as Governance Committee chair PASSED
  - ii) Long range plan for committee On hold; ACTION ITEM for next meeting
- c) Safe Sport & Operational Risk JP Merchant
  - i) Operation Risk
    - (1) looking at sit and slide (3 point entry) for warm ups; looking at data, how to enforce and educate
    - (2) Backward start certification for swimmers just like the forward start with and without ledge; checklist to be published soon
  - ii) Safe Sport
    - (1) Scenario based training-meet in a box containing materials for meets as it relates to safe sport; digital version will also be available
    - (2) New learning platform for APT for next renewal period (2019); continuing education format giving members 2 years to achieve the 75 credits needed to recertify
    - (3) Southern Zone will be testing the club level safe sport certification; each club will have a coordinator as a point person to distribute information; kickoff 2018

  - Athlete workshop in conjunction with IMX camp in January; promoting to have club reps there to participate
  - ii) Hosting State Games in June targeting summer league teams

Any requests for funds should include a short description as to why the funds are needed and a call-back telephone number that the Treasurer can easily reach the requester at.

## LSC Structure and Succession Plan Governance Committee Vision

The LSC needs to do succession planning to ensure we have good leaders on the BOD with a diversity in background/ideals. Leadership and diversity are important to ensure future plans are well thought out and enacted.

In addition, The BOD needs to be more strategic (future looking) in focus instead of operational (current activities). The board can't be completely strategic since the LSC does not have a large staff. Currently the board is almost entirely focused on current activities. More of the work needs to be done at the committee level with action taken by the BOD only when it is required (or a change in policy is required).

To determine leadership, the LSC need to have a multi-stage vetting process:

- 1. Get new people involved in committees
- 2. Those that do a good job on committees and enjoy it are made committee chairs.
- 3. Those that demonstrate leadership as committee chairs are put on the slate for election to the BOD.

Of course to do this, several things in our current structure need to change:

- The LSCs needs committees that are active (actually meet) and produce output. Example, NCS
  has a senior, age group and technical planning committees that basically meet twice a year in a
  group (including all coaches at HOD). Maybe these committees should be combined in an
  operations committee to create items for review at HOD instead of creating a task force every
  time a new concept is investigated.
- For succession planning to work, the LSC needs to reduce the size of the BOD significantly since most committee chairs are currently on the BOD. It will also allow the board to more easily focus on strategic issues as opposed to operational issues.

This is the high level vision of the committee. Of course, there are a large number of details that need to be worked out to implement this plan. The committee would like buy in from the BOD before investing the time required to determine how this is implemented.
