2	201.2 SUITS - No Technical Suits may be worn by any 12 & Under USA Swimming athlete member in competition at any Sanctioned, Approved or Observed NCS meet.
4 5 6	(1) Exceptions to the foregoing restriction are only for a meet in USA Swimming's Championship Series (i.e. Sectionals, Futures, Junior Nationals, Pro Swim Series, US Open, National Championships, and Olympic Trials) or YMCA National Championships.
7	(2) A Technical Suit is one that has the following components: 75
8 9	a. Any male or female suit with any bonded or taped seams is defined as a technical suit regardless of its fabric or silhouette; or
10 11 12 13	b. Any male or female suit with woven fabric extending to the knee or mid-thigh is defined as a technical suit regardless of the type seams: bonded, taped or sewn. (Note: A woven suit with sewn seams and in a male brief or female regular cut not to the knees is not defined as a technical suit and is not restricted.)
