ARTICLE 4 - HOUSE OF DELEGATES

4.6 ANNUAL AND REGULAR MEETINGS - The annual meeting of the House of Delegates of NCS shall be held in the fall. Regular meetings of the House of Delegates will also be held each spring.

.1 The annual meeting of the House of Delegates of NCS shall be held in the Fall at which all legislative proposals will be considered and elections will be conducted.

<u>.2 Regular LSC Business meetings will be held in the spring, which will include the Operations</u> <u>Committee meeting to approve the upcoming short course season.</u>

ARTICLE 6 - OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS 6.2 OTHER DIRECTORS

.1 ATHLETE REPRESENTATIVES - Two (2) Athlete Representatives shall be elected, one each year for a two-year term, or until their respective successors are elected. At the time of election, the Athlete Representative must (a) be an athlete member in good standing; (b) be at least a sophomore in high school or at least 16 years of age, (c) be currently competing, or have competed within the three (3) immediately preceding years, in the program of swimming conducted by NCS or another LSC; and (d) have his or her place of permanent residence in the Territory and expect to reside therein throughout at least the first half of the term (other than periods of enrollment in an institution of higher education). The election of Athlete Representatives shall be conducted annually during Spring the annual meeting of the HOD, or other regularly scheduled meeting designated by the Board of Directors.

6.2 OTHER DIRECTORS

.1 ATHLETE REPRESENTATIVES -

Two (2) Athlete Representatives shall be elected, one each year for a two-year term, or until their respective successors are elected. At the time of election, the Athlete Representative must (a) be an athlete member in good standing; (b) be at least a sophomore in high school or at least 16 years of age, (c) be currently competing, or have competed within the three (3) immediately preceding years, in the program of swimming conducted by NCS or another LSC; and (d) have his or her place of permanent residence in the Territory and expect to reside therein throughout at least the first half of the term (other than periods of enrollment in an institution of higher education). The election of Athlete Representative shall be conducted annually during Spring the Annual HOD, or other regularly scheduled meet designated by the Board of Directors. The balloting shall take place at a meeting called for that purpose by the Athletes Committee, or failing that, at a time and in a manner designated by a majority of the Athlete Members in good standing present and voting who are thirteen (13) years of age or older.

SCHEDULING .1 Except when the House of Delegates determines otherwise by a 2/3 majority, the schedule for each short course season (September through approximately April) shall be approved by one representative from each club in attendance at the Operations Committee meeting at the corresponding House of Delegates Spring LSC Business meeting the previous Spring. and <u>T</u>the schedules for each long course season (approximately May through August) shall be approved by one representative from each club in attendance at the Operations Committee meeting at the corresponding House of Delegates Spring LSC Business meeting the previous Spring. and <u>T</u>the schedules for each long course season (approximately May through August) shall be approved by one representative from each club in attendance at the Operations Committee meeting at the corresponding House of Delegates meeting the previous Fall.

.4 The Scheduling Coordinator/staff, shall post the scheduling framework to the North Carolina Swimming website at least forty (40) days prior to the upcoming House of Delegates/Spring LSC Business meeting.

.5 Based on the scheduling framework, the Scheduling Coordinator/staff shall solicit bids from member clubs and prepare a recommended schedule for consideration by at the Operations Committee <u>meetings</u> at the Fall House of Delegates and Spring LSC Business meetings.

.7 For a meet that has been properly bid to remain on the schedule-and sent to the House of Delegates, a representative of the host club must be present at the Operations Committee meeting.

ARTICLE 202: MEET SCHEDULING PROCESS

202.1. SCHEDULING

.8 Once approved, the schedule shall be open to additional meets if any such meet does not conflict with a protected date. Any requests for additional meets must be submitted to the Scheduling Coordinator and the sanctions committee prior to the appropriate sanction request deadline (30 days prior to the meet start date for closed, dual, tri or quad meets and 60 days prior the meet start date for all other type meets). Requests for additional meets that are made after the sanction request deadline shall be assessed a late fee in addition to the sanction fee as detailed in the summary chart in section 204.6. Meet requests within 8 days of the meet start date will not be considered. The Scheduling Coordinator shall have the authority to approve or reject any additional meets submitted for scheduling approval. A club may appeal any rejection or fine to the Operations Committee.
